Mary Pickford	125,000
A fruity rum cocktail invented for a Canadian-American film actress during her Cuban escapade with Charlie Chaplin	
White Lady	185,000
Two different bartenders in two different countries claim it; the result is one deliciously citrus & slightly herbal concoction	
Bacardi Cocktail	185,000
A staple of the 1930s bar repertoire; a simple twist of the classic Daiquiri, adding a fruity hint of sweetness & a little bit of colour
